Footnotes

TRINNIBERG, away in good order, prompted the pace outside SUM OF THE PARTS while under a confident hold, moved to command approaching the stretch, kicked clear when roused left handed, widened a bit inside the furlong marker then held THE LUMBER GUY at bay under steady hand encouragement. THE LUMBER GUY, in a bit tight soon after the break, quickly recovered and reached a tracking spot three wide, had dead aim on the dueling leaders mid turn, entered the stretch four wide, gave valiant chase but could gain little in the final seventy yards. SMILING TIGER was sent up between horses nearing the half mile marker and gained a forward spot, chased three wide inside rivals mid turn, shifted out wider for the stretch run and kept on willingly to the wire. SUM OF THE PARTS accelerated inside rivals to take command after a sixteenth of a mile, took pressure from the winner, lost the lead nearing the stretch, continued a solid presence past the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly. JUSTIN PHILLIP was steadied when put in tight soon after the break, gained ground along the rail entering the lane, worked outward in the final furlong and finished with interest. FAST BULLET rated close up while saving ground, came under pressure mid turn, chased the leaders into the lane then faded in the final furlong. COIL, shuffled back in the opening sixteenth, was taken wide nearing the half mile pole, gathered some momentum four to five wide mid turn, was floated out to about the eight path straightening for home and mustered a mild late response. AMAZOMBIE, in range three to four wide, was pushed along past the three eighths pole, could not keep pace into the lane and gave way between rivals. JIMMY CREED, hustled along towards the inside, eased out three wide for the drive but had no rally. HAMAZING DESTINY, four wide, had no impact. GANTRY came out soon after the start and was bumped, raced near the rail early, shifted out into the lane but failed to menace. CAPITAL ACCOUNT, sluggish from the gate, raced wide and was outrun. BOXEUR DES RUES, well wide, never

threatened. POSEIDON'S WARRIOR, four to five wide giving hard pursuit, faltered after a half mile.
