1 1/4 MILES. (1.59<sup>2</sup>) 8th Running THE BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC (Grade I). Purse \$3,000,000. 3-year-olds and upward. Weight: 3-year-olds, 122 lbs. Older, 126 lbs. Fillies and mares allowed 3 lbs. Value of race \$3,000,000. Value to winner \$1,560,000, second \$600,000, third \$360,000, fourth \$168,000, fifth \$60,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$78,000, second \$30,000, third \$18,000; Foal, winner \$78,000, second \$30,000, third \$18,000.

Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E. B. F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

BLACK TIE AFFAIR, away alertly, was rated along on the lead while saving ground, held a clear advantage into the stretch and was roused to turn back TWILIGHT AGENDA in a long drive. The latter bobbled at the break, recovered quickly to race within easy striking distance while outside the leaders, went after BLACK TIE AFFAIR approaching the stretch and continued on with good courage. UNBRIDLED, outrun to the far turn, moved between horses entering the stretch but failed to seriously menace with a mild rally. FLY SO FREE, allowed to follow the early leaders, moved menacingly approaching the stretch but failed to sustain his bid. STRIKE THE GOLD, outrun for more than six furlongs, raced seven wide into the stretch and made up some ground late. FESTIN, badly outrun until near the stretch, failed to threaten while racing eight wide through the stretch. MARQUETRY, reserved early, was sent between horses while advancing on the far turn but lacked a further response. CHIEF HONCHO, five wide into the backstretch, maintained his position until near the stretch and tired. SUMMER SQUALL, eased back in close quarters inside BLACK TIE AFFAIR nearing the first turn, remained a factor for seven furlongs and gave way. STAR OF GDANSK, prominent for a mile, had nothing left. CUDAS, fractious in the gate, broke slowly, was sent up along at the first turn, then was finished nearing the end of the backstretch and was not persevered with approaching the finish.
