Footnotes

AUTHENTIC set the pace early with a loose lead from off the rail, stayed off the rail into the lane, kicked clear near the eighth pole and stayed clear of foes in the final stages under a brisk drive. IMPROBABLE came in early on and bothered multiple foes while being bumped himself, raced four wide along the first turn, the five path along the backstretch, made a bid three wide nearing the lane, continued on down the lane but was no match for the winner in the final stages while second best. GLOBAL CAMPAIGN was bumped and bothered shortly after leaving the gate, chased the pace along the backstretch, was in the three path into the lane while making a bid, continued that bid down the lane but flattened out late in the drive. TACITUS was unhurried early on,

raced off the rail into the lane, made a bid down the lane but leveled off late in the drive. MAXIMUM SECURITY tracked the pace early on, was on the inside into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. TIZ THE LAW stalked the pace while under tight restraint from the inside, shifted out into the four path entering the lane and flattened out late in the stretch drive. TITLE READY was bothered and squeezed back shortly after leaving the gate, raced along the back of the field, was on the inside into the lane and moved up in the stretch run. BY MY STANDARDS wandered out and was bumped early on, chased the pace along the backstretch, was in the four path into the lane and empty down the lane. TOM'S D'ETAT was put in tight and jostled shortly after leaving the gate, raced along the back of the field, was in the five path into the lane making a slight bid but could not sustain it and tired down the lane. HIGHER POWER was unprepared at the start and always raced along the back. Due to an issue with timing during the live running of the race, fractional and final times were calculated using video review.
