MCKINZIE was asked leaving the gate, went four wide while inside of PRESERVATIONIST on the first turn, was taken back off the pace late on that bend, stalked the leader on the outside while far out in the track, was coaxed along in the four path on the far turn, took the lead under his own power into upper stretch then was asked for a bit more, responded well under a moderate hand ride in the final furlong and proved best to win ridden out. YOSHIDA (JPN) angled in at the rear early, rounded the first turn in the two path, was unhurried while reserved at the back of the field, started the far turn in the two path, angled six wide inside the three-eighths pole then advanced quickly into contention, came seven wide into the stretch while asked for more run, pursued the winner in the drive and finished with good courage to safely secure the place. VINO ROSSO was hustled from the start, went three wide early on the first turn then angled five wide, settled outside under some urging on the backstretch, advanced while chasing four wide on the far turn, spun six wide into the stretch, pursued the winner under a drive into the final furlong and weakened but earned the show. PRESERVATIONIST was washy during the warm-up then last to commence, went five wide on the first turn, moved to the lead at the seven-eighths pole then shook clear onto the backstretch, set the pace through sensible fractions while well off the inside, rounded the far turn in the three path, was given his cue around the five-sixteenths, lost the advantage to the winner into the stretch, drifted in while dropping back in the vicinity of the furlong marker and gave way. FOREWARNED raced in the two path on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, began the far turn in the three path, was carried seven wide inside the three-eighths, dropped to five then four wide late on that bend and failed to threaten then stumbled after the race and fell while unseating the rider but returned to his feet and was walked off. MONONGAHELA traveled around the first turn in the three path, settled off the pace, was urged along passing the half-mile, dropped from the two path to the rail early on the far turn, advanced while chasing the leader, saved ground in good striking position into upper stretch but came up empty. IMPERATIVE saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the back, came under urging while inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide around the five-sixteenths under the whip, moved out in upper stretch and failed to respond.
