Footnotes

MUTASAABEQ hesitated at the sta, trailed the field in the three path around both turns, commenced a rally while circling the field eight wide turning for home, produced a strong kick in upper stretch to bid outside of INTO THE SUNRISE passing the furlong pole, and drove clear in the late stages. ABARTA was urged along racing in midpack two to three wide down the backstretch, but retreated between foes around the far turn to trail the field in upper stretch, altered course to the eight path in midstretch, and produced a late rally outside of NATHAN DETROIT to achieve place in the late stages. NATHAN DETROIT was bumped behind at the start, settled far off of the pace two wide, swung seven wide turning for home, but was outkicked by MUTASAABEQ in upper stretch, needed correction to keep from lugging in and shied a bit as that foe cleared and crossed over, then stayed on through the lane inside of ABARTA. INTO THE SUNRISE set the pace while staying a bit off of the rail, kicked clear in upper stretch, but was overhauled by MUTASAABEQ approaching the sixteenth pole, and yielded thereafter. ARREST ME RED stuttered a bit and was jostled between horses at the start, stalked along the inside and from the pocket, then attempted a rail bid in upper stretch, but flattened out. PRIVATE ISLAND stumbled at the start, then raced far off of the pace in about the two path, and stayed on along the inside through the stretch. SPYGLASS tracked from midpack six to five wide around the turns, but tired

in upper stretch. BARRISTER TOM was caught in the five path while prompting the pace into the first turn, shifted three wide around that bend, stalked down the backstretch, but weakened four wide in upper stretch. BLAME THE BOOZE broke outwards, prompted the pace from the four path into the first turn, shifted down to the two path around that bend, stalked down the backstretch, but weakened in midstretch. INDY TOURIST bumped an outer foe at the start, tracked from midpack, shifted four wide turning for home, but lacked a rally, then was eased in midstretch. REALLY SLOW was off slow and bumped at the start, then saved ground, but weakened.
